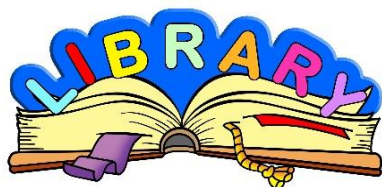
The Principal's Prize Box!
