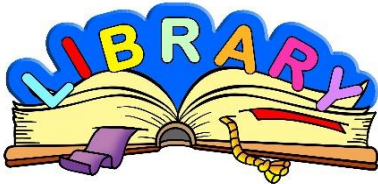
Thank you Maroota P & C for everything you have given the school in 2019, over the past years and into the future.

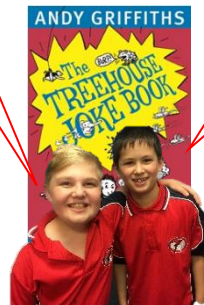

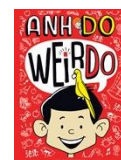
