




Maths at home

This term at Maroota we have been focusing on improving our numeracy skills and understanding. We have learnt that mathematical concepts are all around us.

Numeracy is necessary for everyday living. From daily activities like telling the time and setting the table to more difficult tasks such as planning a trip, reading a map and understanding timetables.



Here are some fun and simple activities you can do at home to help your child build their interest and confidence in mathematics. Start by going on a MATHS HUNT and see how many ways you use maths in your everyday lives.

Baking!

Measurement, counting, timers, arranging things in rows and columns...Sounds like the perfect way to incorporate a range of mathematical ideas. Bonus: Cookies or cake to reward all your hard work!

Car Park Counting

Pick a colour and count all the cars of that colour in the carpark. Want to make it harder? Assign an amount to each colour eg. Red- 1 point, Blue- 10 points and Yellow- 100 points. Now add them all up!

Board/Card Games

Not only are board and card games a great way to spend time with your family, think about all of the mathematics involved. Identifying numbers, counting, adding money, patterns, problem solving. The possibilities are endless

At the Playground

- Find a way to balance the seesaw
- Time and compare how long it takes each person to complete the monkey bars
- How many steps from the slide to the swings? How many metres?
- Give directions to find 'pirate's treasure' at the park
